About Centre for Entrepreneurship Development:

Minds of the younger generation have been opened up in the process of India's march into the liberalized era. Success stories of Indian IT, biotech and other high-tech companies and the exceptional performance of Indian entrepreneurs have begun to fire the imagination of younger minds and motivated the youth towards entrepreneurship and start-up venturing. 6. To support young Entrepreneurs through Techno-managerial activities.
7. To conduct research on entrepreneurship: a competitive advantage to technocrats.
