




RESOLUTIONS OF THE INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC) MEETING


Sub (1)	:	To confirm the minutes of the previous IQAC meeting held on 14.10.2023

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
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
Sub (8)	:	To discuss the modalities for improving overall results (CGPA) of students
Res.	:	Dean (Student Welfare) presented the modalities for improving overall results Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of students. She has presented the modalities in terms of Diagnostic tests, Active Learning, Practice Problems, Regular Reviews, Monitoring student's attendance, Remedial Classes for weak students and Utilization of Available Resources. It was discussed and suggested to implement these strategies to improve the overall academic performance and CGPA.
Sub (9)	:	To discuss the modalities for improving quality of placement training to enhance campus recruitment.
Res.	:	Dean (Career Guidance) presented the present status of placement and modalities for improving quality of placement training to enhance campus recruitment. He has highlighted the effective placement training along with Industry-Relevant Curriculum, Soft Skills Training, Mock Interviews and Assessments and Collaboration with Industry. It was discussed and suggested to implement these strategies to improve the campus recruitment. Some of the suggestions by Principal (IQAC Chairman) are as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Effective placement training strategy needs to be worked out ii. Depute the faculty for "Train the Trainers" programmes iii. Academic load of the student may be reduced wherever possible iv. Allocate the placement training time slots in every department time table v. Minimum two faculty members per department should be designated for placement training
Sub (10)	:	To discuss about Madan Malaviya Teachers Training Program
Res.	:	Dean (Quality Assurance) presented the details of Madan Malaviya Teachers Training Program. He has highlighted the program objective i.e., to enhance the quality of teacher education and professional development in India. It was discussed and suggested for faculty members to undergo the Madan Malaviya Teachers Training Program.
Sub (11)	:	To discuss about modalities for implementation of proposed PARAKH program
Res.	:	Dean (Quality Assurance) briefed the PARAKH program, launched by the Government of India, stands for Performance Assessment, Review, and Analysis of Knowledge for Holistic Development. He highlighted the program objective in improving the quality of



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

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

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

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

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

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

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

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

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

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

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

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
	education through a systematic approach to assessing student performance and ensuring holistic development. It was discussed and suggested to implement the program for educational assessment and data-driven improvements in education.
