EVENT OVERVIEW:

Round 1:

Virtual Kickoff – Online Presentation

- **Date:** September 18th
- **Objective:** Teams will present their initial approach to the problem statements provided (IT or Electrical/Electronic) via a virtual format.
- **Details:** Each team will deliver a detailed presentation outlining their proposed solutions, methodologies, and findings. This is your chance to showcase the originality of your idea and the strength of your strategy.
- **Outcome:** After the presentations, teams will be paired with another team from their domain. This pairing will play a crucial role in the next round, where collaboration is key to refining the solution.

Round 2:

Collaborative Showcase – Offline Presentation

- **Date:** September 20th
- **Objective:** Teams will present a unified, combined solution after collaborating with their paired team.
- **Details:** This round focuses on how the teams integrate their respective approaches into a cohesive and innovative solution. The presentation should highlight collaboration and the technical aspects of the enhanced solution.
- **Judging Criteria:** Judges will evaluate creativity, technical accuracy, feasibility, and the collaborative effort demonstrated in the solution. Some teams may be eliminated based on performance in this round.

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Round 3:

Critical Insights – Debate

- **Date:** September 20th
- **Objective:** Engage in a debate to critique and defend solutions presented by other teams.
- **Details:** This is an opportunity to critically evaluate the work of competing teams while defending your own approach. Judges will assess how well teams handle criticism and respond to challenges, which will influence advancement to the next round.
- **Outcome:** Teams will gain valuable insights that can be used to refine their solution for the next round. Some teams may be eliminated based on performance in this round.

Round 4:

Enhanced Solutions – Refined Presentation

- **Date:** September 20th
- **Objective:** Based on feedback received during the debate, teams will refine their solutions and present the improved version.
- **Details:** Teams should focus on making tangible enhancements to their solution, reflecting their ability to iterate and improve based on constructive criticism. The presentation should demonstrate not only technical excellence but also the evolution of the team's approach.
- **Outcome:** Teams will be judged on the effectiveness of their improvements and the robustness of their final solution.

EVENT RULES AND GUIDELINES:

1.Presentation Template and Content: All presentations must strictly adhere to the template provided by the event organizers. Ensure that all necessary information related to your solution is included, including problem identification, methodology, and innovative features.

2.Team Registration: Each team must consist of exactly four members. Diversity in skill sets within your team is encouraged for optimal problem-solving. Teams must submit the necessary and authentic information of each member during registration. Accurate and complete information is essential for eligibility and communication purposes. Teams should register by the deadline to avoid any complications.

3.Collaboration Requirement: Teams will be paired with another team from their domain after the initial online presentation. Successful collaboration with the paired team is crucial for developing a combined solution for the next round. Teams must work together effectively to produce a unified solution, which will be presented in Round 2.

4.Presentation Duration: Each presentation, whether initial or refined, must be completed within the decided duration. Teams are encouraged to be concise but thorough, leaving time for questions if necessary.

5.Adherence to Judges Decisions: Participants must comply with all feedback and decisions made by the judges. The judges' decisions are final and binding throughout the event.
